# CM: Public cooperation a must for success of 'Safe City Project'

CCTV cameras mandatory at commercial establishments, intersections, hospitals and educational institutions, says Yogi

LUCKNOW : Chief minister Yogi Adityanath on Friday emphasized on the role of public cooperation in ensuring the success of the 'Safe City Project', saying that CCTV cams should be compulsorily installed at commercial establishments, intersections, government and private hospitals, as well as educational institutions.

"The importance of CCTV cams in crime control should be explained to common people, businessmen, and institution operators in order to encourage them to install cameras," said the CM while reviewing the progress of the 'Safe City Project', according to a statement issued by the state government.

The CM stated that though people can keep their CCTV footage data safe with them, it

should be ensured that the footage is only made available to the police, when necessary.

In addition, municipal corporations, the Smart City Project, or local administrations and police will install CCTVs wherever they are needed, he added. Adityanath issued a directive to ensure that all police stations were equipped with CCTV cameras within one week.

He stated that the 'Safe City Project' was proving to be helpful in achieving the goal of ensuring women's safety, dignity, and self-reliance. "Through this project in the state, under the Lucknow Police Commissionerate, modern control rooms, pink police booths, Asha

Jyoti Kendras, CCTV cameras, help desks for counsellors in women's police stations, panic buttons in buses, and other security measures were implemented. Now, we have to expand it further," said the CM.

The CM said that 17 municipal corporations and Gautam Buddha Nagar were to be developed as 'safe cities' in the first phase by implementing financial management through convergence and inter-departmental coordination. "In the second phase, the municipalities of 57 district headquarters and, in the third phase, 143 municipalities should be linked to the 'Safe City project'. Special branding should also be done by putting a sign-

board of 'Safe City' at the entrance of all such cities. In this way, UP will be the first state in the country to have the highest number of safe cities (18)," he added.

He said at present, the 'Safe City' project was focused on the safety of women. "We should expand it and also link it to the safety of the elderly, children, and divyangjans," said Adityanath.

During the meeting, officers informed that so far the police had identified 9,396 places for installation of CCTVs in Agra, Aligarh, Bareilly, Jhansi, Kanpur, Lucknow, Moradabad, Prayagraj, Saharanpur, and Varanasi smart cities, out of which 3,489 had been installed with cameras so far.

It was stated that more than 7,600 locations in Ayodhya, Gorakhpur, Firozabad, Mathura, Vrindavan, Shahjahanpur, Meerut, and Ghaziabad would have CCTV cameras.

The CM said to realize the concept of Safe City, verification of drivers of public transport vehicles was necessary. "Drivers of taxis, e-rickshaws, autos, tempos, etc. should be duly police-verified," he emphasised.

# Smriti accuses Rahul Gandhi of insulting people of Amethi

LUCKNOW : Union minister and BJP MP from Amethi, Smriti Irani, on Friday accused Congress leader Rahul Gandhi of "insulting" the people of Amethi, saying he had never contested the elections from the constituency alone, but with the help of 'bicycle', in an apparent reference to the Samajwadi Party. 'Bicycle' is the Samajwadi Party's election symbol.

"He is the owner of his party, while I am a simple worker of my party," Irani told media persons here on reports that the Gandhi scion may contest from Amethi in the 2024 Lok Sabha polls.

She was on a two-day visit to Amethi to announce a CSR initiative by the largest aircraft manufacturing company, Boeing, to open 100 medical camps in her constituency and inaugurate the industrial units launched by various companies.

"In a democracy, anyone has the right to contest from anywhere. But when he left Amethi and went to south India, he insulted the people of Amethi... which people here have not for-

gotten," said Irani.

Asked if she would contest the elections from two places like Gandhi, who contested from Wayanad in Kerala as well as Amethi in 2019, Irani said, "The habit of running away is theirs, not mine."

# AFTER BSP, SP ANNOUNCES FIRST LIST OF CANDIDATES FOR MP POLLS

LUCKNOW : The Samajwadi Party has joined the Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) in announcing the first list of its candidates for the assembly elections in Madhya Pradesh due later this year.

The SP on Wednesday declared its candidates for four constituencies—all of which are in the Bundelkhand and Gwalior-Chambal regions. The party has fielded its candidates in Nivadi, Rajnagar, Bhandera and Mehgaon seats, according to a notice issued by the party chief Akhilesh Yadav's office and shared on the microblogging site X (formerly Twitter).

Parties have begun declaring candidates for the polls, due later this year, even though the Election Commission of India is yet to announce the schedule. Madhya Pradesh has a total of 230 assembly constituencies.

The SP, which aspires to turn into a national party, has previously won assembly seats, outside U.P., in Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, West Bengal, Rajasthan, former Andhra Pradesh (the constituency now falls in Telangana), and Gujarat. HT

# 'This government does not respect women'

A five-term former MLA, Ajay Rai who challenged Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2014 and 2019 Lok Sabha elections, assumed charge as new president of Uttar Pradesh Congress Committee (UPCC) on Thursday.

Rai, considered an aggressive leader, is said to be the choice of All India Congress Committee (AICC) general secretary (in charge Uttar Pradesh) Priyanka Gandhi Vadra and exudes confidence of taking the Congress to success in the 2024 Lok Sabha election. Umesh Raghuvanshi spoke to him about his challenges and the journey ahead:

Will Priyanka Gandhi continue as the AICC general secretary (in charge UP)?

Yes, she will continue as the in charge for UP. She is not going anywhere. I can say this with authority as the UPCC president. We will fight the 2024 Lok Sabha elections under her leadership. Why should there be a question about her being shifted out of Uttar Pradesh?

Will Priyanka Gandhi contest the 2024 Lok Sabha elections?

I will request her to contest from Varanasi. It is for her to take a call where to contest from.

Will she contest from Amethi?

There is a demand for Rahul Gandhi to contest from Amethi. The people of Amethi have made the demand. Union minister Smriti Irani made several promises to the people of Amethi. These promises have not been fulfilled.

Will you contest the 2024 Lok Sabha elections?

The Congress high command will decide. I contested the 2014 and 2019 Lok Sabha elections against PM Narendra Modi from Varanasi on the directives of the party high command.

Are you satisfied with the



turnout of leaders at UPCC headquarters on Thursday?

Yes, workers came from across Uttar Pradesh on Thursday as I took over as the UPCC president. There was a lot of enthusiasm. We will take everybody along as we fight for the people of Uttar Pradesh.

What about factionalism in Congress?

We will take all the party workers along with us. We will seek cooperation of all the former UPCC presidents. These include Ajay Kumar Lallu, Brijlal Khabri and all other former UPCC presidents.

Is the zonal system gone?

Yes, the UPCC's six zones are no longer there. We will constitute the UPCC organisation afresh soon. We will have the UPCC organisation in place by September 2023. We will constitute the district units too by September 2023.

Issues for elections?

There is no dearth of issues. Rising inflation, unemployment and corruption are some of the issues the people are directly concerned with. The bureaucracy is running the government. Legislators are only writing letters and even the ministers or the deputy chief ministers have no powers to effectively act even in the departments under their supervision.

Any specific example?

A woman had to deliver an immature baby on the road along the Raj Bhawan in the state capital. Deputy chief minis-

ter Brajesh Pathak went to the spot. The ambulance, however, did not reach there. The deputy chief minister has not been able to take any effective action against the officers of his department for the lapses in the whole issue. He cannot act against any senior officer.

What about sharing of seats with INDIA alliance?

This will be decided by the party high command.

You said you want Rahul Gandhi as PM after the 2024 Lok Sabha elections?

Yes, this is what I have said.

But the INDIA alliance is yet to decide a candidate for the PM's post?

I have said we want Rahul Gandhi as prime ministerial candidate, contesting all the 80 Lok Sabha seats. The Congress high command will take a call in case of sharing of seats.

Will BSP join the alliance?

This is an issue that the BSP leadership can answer.

Your take on the law-and-order situation?

There is no law and order in U.P. We see crime rising.

What about the crime against women?

This government does not have respect for women.

How?

Amar Mani Tripathi, the former minister and convict (along with his wife Madhumani Tripathi) in Madhumita Shukla murder case is being released from jail. Amar Mani Tripathi was not sent to jail for fighting for the people. He was convicted in a crime against a woman. Chinmayanand was accused of rape. Sakshi Maharaj was accused of crime against women. BJP's Kuldeep Sengar has been convicted on charges of rape. They are all BJP leaders. They don't respect women.

# Ghosi battle intensifies as Mukhtar family bats for SP

LUCKNOW : The tussle for Ghosi bypoll has intensified with jailed mafia-politician Mukhtar Ansari's family throwing weight behind Samajwadi Party candidate Sudhakar Singh.

Suhaib Ansari, SP MLA from Mohammadabad, and son of former MLA Sibgatullah Ansari (elder brother of Mukhtar), campaigned extensively in Ghosi's largely Muslim dominated areas and villages for two days till Thursday.

In Ghosi bypolls, SP's Sudhakar Singh is locked in a straight fight with the ruling BJP's Dara Singh Chauhan. Both are one-time former MLAs from this seat. The bypoll to the seat was necessitated after Dara Singh Chauhan, who was SP MLA on the seat, resigned from his assembly membership and joined the BJP.

While Suhaib has already campaigned, sources in the SP said soon his father Sibgatullah Ansari too is likely to campaign for Sudhakar.

On Wednesday, Suhaib tweeted that he had campaigned for Sudhakar Singh.

Mukhtar's is a politically influential family in the Mau-Ghazi region. He and his two brothers had been legislators from the region. Jailed Mukhtar's other brother Afzal too is a gangster-turned-politician, but Sibgatullah has no criminal antecedents.

Mukhtar's son Abbas Ansari

is an MLA as he won the Mau assembly seat as Suheldev Bharatiya Samaj Party (SBSP) in alliance with the SP, while his cousin Suhaib won the Mohammadabad assembly seat (in Ghazipur) in 2022 as SP candidate.

Sibgatullah, who had been MLA from the same seat twice (once as SP member and the second time as QED-Qaumi Ekta Dal) and Suhaib had joined the SP in 2021.

On Friday, SP chief national general secretary Ramgopal Yadav went to Ghosi to review the party's preparation for the bypoll. When newsmen asked him about Mukhtar's family campaigning for the SP in Ghosi, Ramgopal said: "Just one person in a family being a criminal does not make the entire family so." When asked about Mukhtar's nephew Suhaib campaigning for Sudhakar, he said: "If he is an SP MLA wouldn't he campaign for an SP candidate."

# 'VARANASI CULTURE MINISTERS' DECLARATION AFTER SATURDAY MEETING'

VARANASI : The 'Varanasi Culture Ministers' Declaration' will be issued after a meeting of the culture ministers of the G20 nations on Saturday, Union minister of culture G Kishan Reddy said.

Addressing a press conference on the eve of the meeting scheduled in Varanasi, Reddy said CM Yogi Adityanath would also be attending the event, Sur Vasudha, in which artists from the member nations would perform.

Moreover, discussions on the draft declaration at the fourth G20 Culture Working Group (CWG) Meeting, under India's Presidency, with the delegates from the G20 members, and international organisations participating concluded in Varanasi, on Friday. Reddy said Varanasi culture meetings have created an opportunity to discuss multi-dimensional global relations related to the cultural sector.

"G20 Varanasi Culture Ministerial declaration will be made on Saturday at the end of the meeting (of G20 culture ministers)," said Reddy and added the final draft would be placed in the meeting for adoption.

Speaking on the occasion MoS, Culture, Meenakshi Lekhi said India's presidency brought out the beautiful tapestry of the cultural milieu of the country and Varanasi, specifically, which has been chosen as the UNESCO city of heritage for music. HT

# 63 lakh more families to have access to Ayushman Bharat scheme in U.P.

LUCKNOW : An additional 63 lakh families in Uttar Pradesh will soon be included in the Ayushman Bharat scheme, said principal secretary of health, Partha Sarthi Sen Sharma at a programme 'Agenda Ayushman Samvad: Healthcare Excellence in Uttar Pradesh' organised on Friday to mark five years of the health scheme.

"The families eligible according to the socio-economic caste census already got covered under the Ayushman Bharat scheme and now the centre has given consent to add 13 lakh more families while another 50 lakh families will be added in place of those families who despite being enrolled did not get Ayushman cards made," said Sangeeta Singh, CEO, the state agency for comprehensive health and integrated services (Sachis) that is monitoring Ayushman Bharat scheme in

Uttar Pradesh.

The selection criteria have also been decided. "The 50 lakh new families will be those having six or more members and who are eligible under the National Food Security Act. They will be registered for the Ayushman Bharat scheme," said Sangeeta Singh.

Another 13 lakh families will be those who have only women in the family. This being a vulnerable group the focus is to ensure more women get Ayushman Bharat cover which provides Rs 5 lakh health insurance for a year. Deputy CM Brajesh Pathak while addressing the programme said, "PM Narendra Modi's vision is being fully realized in U.P. Ayushman Bharat is helping patients to get treatment at private hospitals also without any deposit."

In Uttar Pradesh, a total of 3.03 crore beneficiaries have been issued Ayushman Bharat cards and in terms of coverage, 67% of families are covered. HT
