NEW AYODHYA TOWNSHIP

States vie for land as online plot registration starts from Nov 10

Pawan Dixit letters@htlive.com LUCKNOW: As the Yogi Adityanath government opens online registration process for allotment of land to mutts and ashrams in Ayodhya, several states have approached the Uttar Pradesh government for land in the temple town. These states plan to open their state guest houses in Ayodhya.

Government for allotment of land in Ayodhya, said Neeraj Shukla, additional housing commissioner, Housing Board. The state government is all set to roll out new Ayodhya greenfield township project

from November 10 by inviting online applications for allotment of plots for mutts, ashrams, dharamshalas and commercial purposes. Commercial plots will be allotted through e-auction. The township will come up on 1407-acre land on both sides of the Lucknow-Gorakhpur highway. In the second phase, it will be extended by 442-acre. "The online registration of plots for mutts and ashrams will end on November 30," said housing commissioner Ranveer Prasad. "Commercial plots will be allotted through e-auction for which registration will start from November 10 and end on November 24. The auction will take place on November 25,"

Prasad added. In the first phase, 28 plots have been earmarked for mutts/ashrams each measuring 1,966 sq m to 10,417 sq m. Besides, 12 commercial plots, each measuring 1,543 sq m to 9,252 sq m, will be allotted. Proposal for fixing price of plots will be tabled at the meeting of the Housing Board on November 9. The Housing Board has also invited applicants to visit the site from October 30 onwards. The state government has conceptualised the new Ayodhya greenfield township project to decongest the temple town as foothold of devotees in Ayodhya will rise manifold after Ram temple opens for devotees on January 22 next year.

Tender process for 'Heritage Hotels' extended by 10 days

LUCKNOW: The eagerly anticipated entry of the common man as a valued hotel guest into some of Lucknow's enchanting Nawab-era heritage buildings has been postponed by an additional 10 days. This delay results from a shortage of interested companies in the tender process for three captivating structures - Chattr Manzil, Roshan-Uddaula Kothi, Kothi Gulistan-e-Iram, and Kothi Darshan Vilas. This 10-day extension of the tender process means that heritage enthusiasts will have to exercise more patience before they can revel in the grandeur of these historic monuments. Additionally, the delay affects not only Lucknow but also Chunar Fort in Mirzapur, Barua Sagar Fort in Jhansi, Barsana

Jal Mahal in Mathura, Shukla Talab in Kanpur Dehat, and Tikait Rai Baradari in Kanpur city. All of these sites were part of a tender to convert them into exquisite five-star heritage hotels without compromising their original facade and structure. A spokesperson from the state's tourism department clarified, "The scarcity of participants in the tender process does not signify a lack of interest in these invaluable heritage sites. The primary reason for the limited turnout is the inexperience of many potential bidders in the intricacies of filing tenders." The spokesperson added, "This project, designed to rejuvenate tourism in the state capital and across Uttar Pradesh, is deemed vital for unlocking the state's tourism potential." Reputed players in the country's hotel industry, such as Nirvana Hotels, Oberois, MRS

Group, Leela Group, Mahindra Group, and Ramada Group, have previously expressed their keen interest in managing these unique heritage sites within the state. However, the complexity of the tender process has proven to be a stumbling block for these major players, resulting in the need for a ten-day extension. The Uttar Pradesh tourism department remains committed to this tender process, recognising the numerous advantages that transforming heritage buildings into hotels can bring. Besides, it is expected that this initiative will yield substantial revenue for the Uttar Pradesh treasury, create both direct and indirect employment opportunities through tourism-related activities, breathe new life into the tourism sector, and promote a wide array of products and services.

'EMAIL BLASTING' GANG BUSTED; 9 HELD FOR DUPING PEOPLE ABROAD

LUCKNOW: The Special Task Force (STF) on Tuesday busted a gang that ran a 'fake' call centre and was involved in 'email blasting' and arrested nine persons from Indira Nagar in the state capital. Email blasting is sending emails to many recipients at once. he emails were sent to people abroad asking them to call the gang back on a 'toll-free number'. The calls received were then diverted to a voice over internet protocol (VoIP) application to fool callers in the name of renewing their subscriptions for online IT services. The arrested men were identified as Muteen Khan, Khalid Raza, Deepak Jaiswal, Bakhtyar Ali, Shoaib, Mudassar Alam and Zishan Khan, all natives of West Bengal. Cops also arrested Arpit Maurya of Ayodhya and Vishal Meena of Lucknow. HTC

Sonbhadra fossil park to secure Unesco world heritage status

The state tourism department has initiated the necessary procedures to secure this prestigious designation for the fossil park near Salkhan in Sonbhadra district. According to the minister of tourism and culture, Jaiveer Singh, efforts are being made to secure a spot for the fossil park located in Sonbhadra district on the UNESCO list.

He mentioned that paleontologists and tourists from around the world visit Salkhan throughout the year to explore the fossil park. He also noted that the state government has decided to develop the necessary infrastructure facilities to attract more tourists and provide essential amenities to those visiting the area. The state government is trying to mark U.P. on the world map in terms of tourism. Efforts are being made to present the fossil park to the world by getting it included in the UNESCO list. The tourism further added that the fossils found in the park are algae and stromatolites type fossils. As per an estimate, it is 1400 million years old.

65-year-old gets death penalty for rape, murder of minor girl

Pawan Dixit pawan.dixit@htlive.com LUCKNOW: The Special Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Court on Tuesday awarded death sentence to a 65-year-old man accused of rape and murder. Additional district and sessions judge Shyam Mohan Jaiswal, who holds the charge of POCSO Court, awarded capital punishment to one Kedar Nath Rathore, 65, for raping and thereafter gagging a 10-year old minor to death. Passing the order, the court stated that it could not overlook the unbearable pain and trauma which the minor girl must have undergone at the time of the incident. The POCSO court would fail in discharging its duty if it did not award maximum punishment to the accused, observed the court.

COULD NOT OVERLOOK THE UNBEARABLE PAIN WHICH THE MINOR GIRL MUST HAVE UNDERGONE, SAID THE COURT THE CASE The victim went missing from outside her house in Aliganj on March 16, 2016 and the next day, her father lodged an FIR at the Aliganj police station. Cops recovered the victim's body dumped near Shyam Sat-sang Bhawan, Mahanagar, later in the day. Kedar Nath Rathore, the victim's neighbour, was arrested from the state capital when he was trying to flee. "Kedar Nath Rathore was arrested on the basis of neighbours' statements who had spotted the girl with him for the last time in the evening on March 16, 2016," said Mukesh Tripathi, district government counsel (criminal). Tripathi and advocate Shashi Pathak had represented the state government in court during the trial of the case. "The post mortem examination report of the girl pointed out seven injuries on her body. The accused had gagged the girl to death after raping her when she was writhing in pain," added Tripathi. "The forensic science laboratory report had revealed the presence of male sperm on the clothes of the victim. Involvement of the accused was established beyond any doubt in the court," asserted Tripathi. The court also got the accused examined by a psychiatrist. "The psychiatrist ruled out any psychological disorder in the accused. This helped the court in awarding death penalty," said Tripathi.

Land consolidation cases: Salary of 12 revenue officers held for laxity

LUCKNOW: The salary of 12 officers of the revenue department posted in Varanasi and Vindhyachal divisions has been stopped and an explanation has been sought from the additional district magistrate (ADM), Sonbhadra district, over delay, negligence and irregularities committed in disposal of land consolidation cases pending for more than 10 years. Uttar Pradesh land consolidation commissioner GS Naveen Kumar said, "In view of the direction of the CM, action is being taken on a war footing to settle the pending land consolidation cases in the state." The

land consolidation works of Vindhyachal and Varanasi divisions were reviewed village wise in a meeting held in Varanasi on Tuesday. During the review meeting, the land consolidation commissioner ordered to stop the salary of a dozen of officers on the charges of laxity in work and negligence in disposal of the pending cases. These officers include Narendra Singh, Dhanraj Yadav, Gajadhar Singh, Somnath Mishra, Vinod Kumar Verma, Farhat Ahmed Khan, Shyamdhani Pal, Ramji Shukla, Vijayshankar Singh, Satya Prakash Choubey, Sanjeev Kumar

and Manoj Kumar Singh. An explanation has been sought from ADM, Sonbhadra, Subhash Chandra Yadav for indifference, laxity and negligence in supervision of consolidation work. Instructions were given to the officers for transparent and quality disposal of revenue and land consolidation cases. To provide easy justice to the litigants, the officers were instructed to settle majority of the cases through village courts. Directions were given to scan the dilapidated records of the villages used in the consolidation work with digital photographs. HTC

Subsequently, security was beefed up at the Varanasi air-

port. A senior official said a meeting was held at the airport to enhance security further during the upcoming festive season when the number of passengers increases and some other reasons. Senior officials, including airport director Punit Gupta, along with CISF UP and Police officials attended the security meeting at the airport on Monday. They reviewed security measures and upgraded it further. "The security meeting is held time to time for foolproof security of the airport. KGMU DOCS PERFORM 2 LIVER TRANSPLANTS IN 24 HR

LUCKNOW: Doctors at the King George's Medical University (KGMU) here performed two liver transplants within 24 hours. While one of them was from a living donor, the other was from a brain-dead patient, which, the doctors claimed, was done for the first time in the state in such a short

period. Liver was harvested from a 58-year-old resident of Rajajipuram who was admitted to the KGMU Trauma Centre after a road accident, and has been on ventilator support. The surgical gastroenterology team that performed the transplants was led by Prof Abhijit Chandra (HOD, Dept of Gastroenter-

U.P. to decide uniform menu for Mid-Day Meal scheme & millets

HT Correspondent letters@htlive.com LUCKNOW: The state government, working to provide hot meals to children aged 3 to 6 years at anganwadi centres, is likely to decide on a uniform menu for smooth operation of the Mid-Day Meal scheme. According to the proposal, the same food will be served to children in anganwadi centres which is served to students in basic schools. Post Diwali, anganwadi kids will enjoy food prepared in government schools. This proposal was recently put forward in the state-level task force meeting chaired by chief secretary Durga Shankar Mishra. The task force will take a decision and it might be endorsed by the chief minister, according to a government press release.

Millets a priority The proposal says that approximately 65 per cent of anganwadi centres in the state are located on the premises of primary and upper primary schools. Therefore, the food will be prepared in the kitchens of these schools. Hence, a menu similar to the PM

Menu in anganwadi centres and basic schools to have millet dishes. HT FILE Nutrition Scheme (Mid-Day Meal) has been proposed. The menu for the first day of the week would include roti, seasonal vegetables with added soybean and fresh seasonal fruit. On Tuesday, students will be served rice with dal and vegetables. Wednesday's meal will include 'tahari' with seasonal vegetables and soybeans and on Thursday, the kids will have roti with dal and vegetables. On Friday and Saturday, tahari with seasonal vegetables and soybeans, and dal with rice and vegetables will be served respectively. However, the priority will be given to millets in hot cooked food.
